

Martial Arts Biography of Leo Green

Mr. Green started training in Tae Kwon Do and Hapkido in 1971 while in the Air Force stationed at Offutt Air Force Base in Omaha, Nebraska. His first Tae Kwon Do instructor was the late Grandmaster H.U. Lee, who at that time had just formed the American Tae Kwon Do Association (A.T.A.). Mr. Green's Hapkido instructor was Mr. James Nelson.

Grandmaster Robinson and Mr. Green's current Tae Kwon Do instructor, Grandmaster Mike Brown of the National Tae Kwon Do Federation of America (NTFA) in Jacksonville, Arkansas, were both students of the Late Grand Master H.U. Lee.

Mr. Green's current rank in Tae Kwon Do is 5th degree black belt; his rank in Hapkido in the International Combat Hapkido Federation (ICHF) is 4th degree black belt.

In addition, Mr. Green is a close quarter self-defense master instructor who has trained the U.S. Marines in close quarter combat survival of Stick & Knife Fighting from the Filipino martial arts of Modern Arnis & Kali. His instructors were the late Professor Remy A. Presas and current instructor, Professor Jose Bueno.

Currently, Mr. Green works full time at a law enforcement training facility where he is a Certified Defensive Tactics & Impact Weapons instructor in the Police Arts of Aiki-Ju-Jitsu. Mr. Green has trained Local, State, and Federal law enforcement officers. He also coordinates all training in Weaponless Defense, Impact Weapons, Edged Weapons, Kubotan and Ground Fighting for all law enforcement at the training facility. Moreover, he is the Hapkido instructor for Robinson's Tae Kwon Do.
